Winter Cold Weather Clothing Alert

Dear Parents/Guardians,

This is a friendly reminder that the temperature is going to change drastically from today to tomorrow, there is also the potential of some snow. If students will be playing in the snow on any winter day they must have; boots, snow pants, winter coats, hats, and gloves/mittens. For cold temperatures we will still send the school outside for recess so encourage your students to wear winter coats, hats, gloves/mittens. Aftercare will go outside for a second "recess" so it is imperative that they have "winter wear" due to the fact that they could be outside for as long as an hour. We will remain indoors for recess when the temperature or wind chill is below 0. Please try to label all pieces of clothing with your child's last name. We have many gloves, hats, and coats without names in our lost and found. For our younger students, a reusable plastic bag with handles is best to hold all their winter items, please label bags as well....sometimes these get left on the bus or in the hallways of the school and we can't reunite them with their owners if names are not present.

As part of our Continuous School Improvement Plan we will be sharing some general information regarding topics that pertain to education. The first topic we selected is "School Attendance." Since the pandemic, schools across the country have been grappling with high numbers of absenteeism and tardiness. Even in our own suburban environment this is an issue for schools. We can't stress enough how important it is for our students to be in school. Absent/tardy students put stress on the classroom as a whole, and on teachers who are responsible for teaching concepts on a continuum. There is often not the time or place for teachers to work individually with students who missed critical instruction, project work, and tests. As a school we strive to create a welcoming environment for students, we address interpersonal issues that might be causing barriers to learning and school attendance, and we hope to partner with parents to establish healthy home routines around school attendance. As we enter the second Trimester there is still time to set goals and make some home routine changes in order to support students academically. October 30, 2024 Boo Bash Guidelines for Volunteers & Students

- 1. Parents that have volunteered to set up their trunks: arrive around 8:00 and we will park you in a designated spot. Student rotations begin at 8:30. We are doing trunks rain or shine since volunteers out there are not necessarily Virtus compliant and cannot be brought into the building. The time for rotations will run from 8:30-12:15 for all grades of the school. You can break up the hours you are manning a trunk by assigning time slots to different people if necessary. If you can work the whole time that is fine as well. Please bring candy for your trunk, we are expecting 400 students to parade through the trunks. The office has extra candy if needed, and helpers will go around checking on supplies. If you are a volunteer please arrive around 8:15. Thank you all for volunteering!
- 2. Students will go to (3) different stations for 15 minutes; fire pit s'mores, games in the gym, and trunk-or-treat. PK & K students have "spooky dance party" and s'more chex mix instead of fire & games.
- 3. Students in all grades can wear costumes, there will be prizes given out for "best costumes" in grades PK-1, 2-4, 5-8. Guidance for costumes are as follows: full face masks are discouraged as it is difficult for students to see, and we have younger students in the building who might be scared of full on face masks (if you do wear a mask we will allow it during the trunk-or-treating portion when students are with their class.). No prop weapons allowed in school. Full face makeup is not allowed, you can paint on whiskers, a mustache, stitches etc. No hair dye allowed, however, you may wear a wig as part of your costume that is colored. If you choose not to wear a costume please wear clothing that is in Halloween colors to get in the spirit of the day. Students need to bring a bag or bucket for trunk-or-treating.

Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are enjoying the fair fall weather days here at SGS! Daily recess has been beautiful for all the grades, gym classes can continue to be held outside, the Aftercare children get to enjoy a second recess in the afternoon without coats, and we were able to hold our bus evacuation drill this week with mild temperatures and no rain! This is the time of year when we hold all our compliance drills that are mandated by the Illinois State Board of Education. Coming later in October will be our School Safety Drill. I will coordinate this with the Grayslake Police and our teachers of various grades. For our younger children in grades PK-3 we talk with them about general drill expectations, such as where exits are located in relation to their classroom, and how important it is to stay quiet and listen to their teachers. In the upper grades 4-8 we will actually run two scenarios of a safety threat close to their room location, where an exit is not possible, and a threat located in another part of the building where an exit of the physical building is the safer option. As with all drills, knowing where the exits are, being quiet, and listening to their teacher's directions are paramount. Once I have the date I will share that information with you so that you are aware.

We will be celebrating Bully Awareness Month with a wear "blue" shirt with uniform bottoms on October 7th. **Bully Awareness Day** We want all our students to be kind to each other. Harmful words and actions affect everyone in the school environment. A happy, successful school environment is what all our children deserve.

Some "School Band" news for those students in grades 4-8 who play an instrument or who are interested in learning. Music on the Move was unable to hire an instructor to take over at our school, so I have made the decision to switch to Music Education Services. Many local Catholic schools in our area use this group. Mr. Louie Cruz will be our new band director. Tomorrow 10/4 there will be a demonstration concert for 4th & 5th graders during the school day. On Tuesday 10/8 students who are interested will have a "fitting"; which is a chance to talk with the new Band Director and try out different instruments. Students who are in grades 6-8 will have a meet &

greet on this day with the director. Sign up information and pricing will come home with students. Band classes are set to start October 15th. **Music Education Services (Band)**
