You can see how your child scored by asking them to sign into the iReady Program and showing you the testing results on their screen. Printed results will be available during your conference with your child's teacher in early October. We will be doing conferences with all grades including Preschool. Parents will have the option to select "in-person" or "virtual" for what best fits your schedule. We use a sign-up form and start with the families with the most children first. This will be sent out next week.

Dear Parents/Guardians,

We have completed what amounts to one full week of school, and I want to tell you how "sharp" the children look in their uniforms, new backpacks, shoes and haircuts. There is nothing like the "fresh start" feeling of a new school year. Earlier, I had communicated that the iReady Diagnostic would be given this week and next, however due to an upgrade to Powerschool the Archdiocese of Chicago has been having great difficulty syncing iReady to Powerschool and testing will be delayed. This technology issue affects all iReady products that we use in the school. Teachers are doing their best to adjust, as students are not able to access weekly lessons in iReady for reading and math right now.

This week started our Kiddos hot lunch program, and milk will begin after Labor Day. I am enclosing the "Allergy Aware Policy" for your information. This is from the Parent Handbook which is available on our website: stgilbertschool.org. Voluntary Allergy
Awareness Policy. Food items with nuts, or made from nuts such as peanut butter are not allowed at SGS. We will speak to students kindly in the lunchroom if nuts are present, and ask them to move away from other students to consume the item. Reminders have been given to all students this week by our nurse about being mindful of what is packed in their lunches, and that there is no sharing of food at the lunch table since we cannot control or police food that might have been packaged in a factory where nuts are present, or prepared in restaurants that might have nut products being handled/present. There are no "direct" nuts in any of the food items from the restaurants working with Kiddos.

Grades (1-8) will have Curriculum Night tonight from 6:00-8:00 pm. Please park by the gym and enter the gym doors. We will begin the night in the gym and dismiss parents to go meet with teachers. We will run (3) 20 minute sessions to accommodate families with multiple children. This event is for parents only.

Dear Parents/Guardians,

There has been much excitement in the building for the new beginning of the 2024-25 school year. No matter how many years I have worked in education, even the staff has excitement, and some trepidation with the start of each new year-we are no different than students and parents! It has been a very good start.

I want to thank all of the parents and people who drive for being understanding that the first few weeks might have a few hiccups, but with patience we will work things out and you will develop routines that go smoothly.

I am especially thankful to my morning drivers for heeding my "ask" to stage in the East Lot instead of parking along Wicks St. waiting to be let into our lot. That road cannot accommodate parked cars and still have two way passage for the residents who live in that neighborhood. Many of our neighbors are trying to get to the train station or out to the Lake St. light to head off to their jobs. I have asked people to not begin to pull back to Wicks until 6:55-7:00. Buses arrive at school at 7:00, they then have to unload and conduct their safety checks in our lot. The earliest we will be opening the road to car riders is 7:05. This time is contingent upon no late buses. Please be respectful in the neighborhoods, leave a bit of space so cars can get by each other, and do not block driveways.

For the afternoon car pick-ups we are asking for your help in downloading the PikMyKid App, and having your car tags in your vehicles. Once you are within a 5 mile radius of the school "announce" so that when you reach our check-in person, Cindy Reed, she will see the student numbers on her iPad and simply swipe them into the current group of 24 cars being loaded. Parents with students at Aftercare can also use PikMyKid to announce they are on their way. Aftercare staff watch our "announce" screen and begin communicating to the staff outside to send that child in to go home for the day. This is our 4th year using this App, and it is very important to use it to its capability. It is designed to make your and our life easy. Once we get our routines down we can ackomplish pick up within 15 minutes for over 250 cars. You are responsible for entering your child's mode of transportation each day in this App. The front office is not aware of various schedules for bus, car, aftercare, sports practice etc. Please make your changes by 1:00 in the App, if after call the office.

We feel very blessed that you have chosen St. Gilbert school for your children!
